Yayasan Hasanah (Hasanah), the foundation of Khazanah Nasional Berhad (Khazanah) was born on 1st July 2015 as an independent grant-making foundation, following nine years of corporate social responsibility efforts previously driven by Khazanah Nasional (Khazanah).

In Arabic, Hasanah means “doing good” or “good deeds” and despite our primary grant-making role, we believe in going beyond dollars and cents by working towards the bigger picture of facilitating an entire ecosystem of transformation.

Similar to Khazanah’s purpose of advancing Malaysia by investing to deliver sustainable value for Malaysians, Hasanah invests in people, who are the building blocks of a nation.

Our work focuses on five impact areas – Education, Community Development, Environment, Arts and Public Spaces as well as Knowledge – through which we aim to be a convenor, collaborator, and catalyst of change.

While each impact area has its respective vision, our overarching vision is to build a socially cohesive Malaysia by empowering people, conserving the environment and the arts.

We recognise that building a greater, globally competitive Malaysia does not happen by working in silos. Therefore, we believe in the power of “We” and will continuously champion collective and collaborative actions in the ecosystem.

The number of people Hasanah assisted in 2021 alone represents 66% of the total people we've reached since 2015. Meanwhile, the amount of funds managed, partners involved, and projects overseen made up almost half of the cumulative figures measured since inception.

That being said, these record numbers and overwhelming need for assistance also serve as a grim reminder, revealing the gaps in our social protection system. The pandemic has exposed the sad reality of many individuals who have somehow fallen through the cracks.

Learning from the pandemic-driven struggles over the past two years, the call for a holistic view of social protection issues cannot possibly be overstated. ”

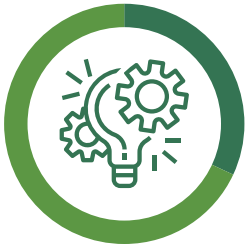

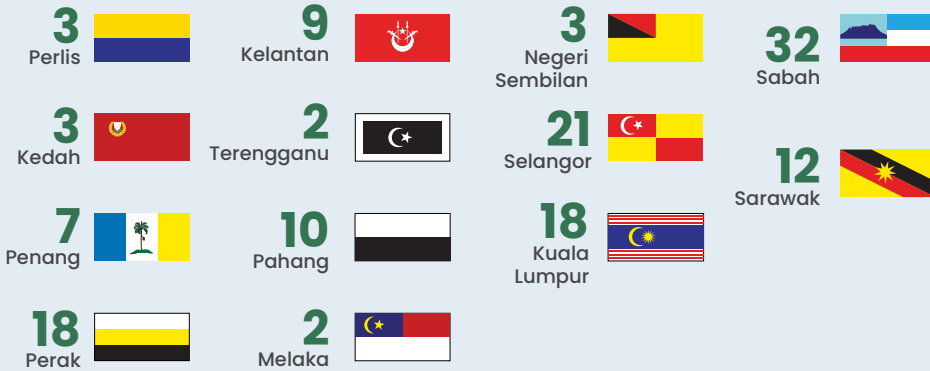

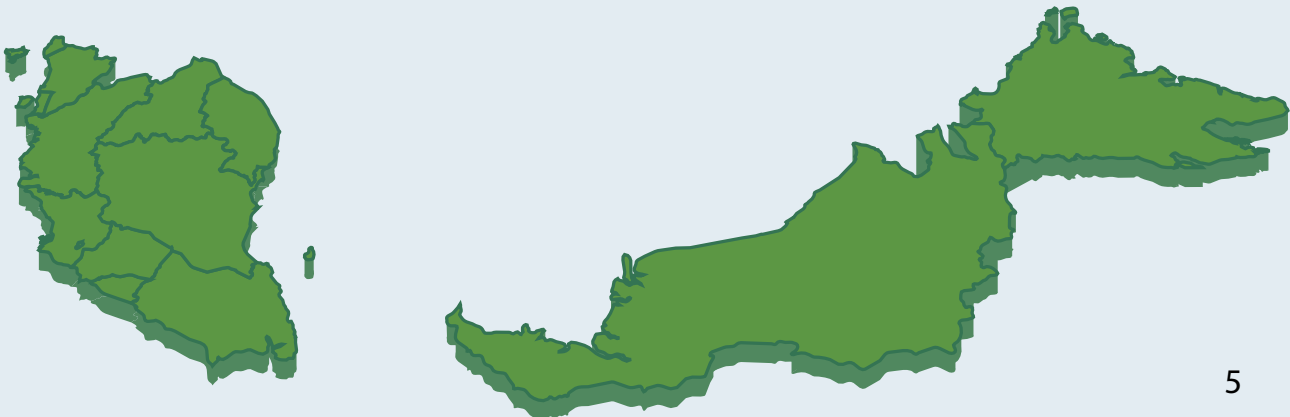

Education for Every Child

“I want to educate my people, my brothers and sisters,” says Bilkuin Jimmysali, seated in the back of Sekolah Bajau Laut Omadal (Iskul Sama Dilaut Omadal in the Bajau language).

The alternative school occupies a bright yellow house that straddles the unofficial demarcation between the homes predominantly occupied by locals and that of the undocumented Bajau Laut community on Omadal Island, Sabah.

For five days a week, it is filled with the chatter and laughter of 33 children who are welcomed despite their lack of legal documentation. A former student himself, Jimmysali is now a *Mastal Arikik* or assistant teacher at the school.

Of River Terrapins, Sewing Machines and Batik

What do river terrapins, sewing machines and batik have in common?

To most, nothing.

But to 49-year-old Azlina binti Zakaria (or Kak Na), it's a whole different story.

Thanks to a community empowerment project hatched by the co-founder of Turtle Conservation Society of Malaysia (TCS), Dr. Chen Pelf Nyok in 2019, Kak Na can now earn about RM1,000 to RM1,500 by sewing crafts for TCS.

Dancing on the Bright Side: A Time for Reflection and Rebirth

Like many arts practitioners, Odissi dancer Geethika Sree's life drastically changed when the COVID-19 pandemic hit.

"Dance has always been a constant in my life. When I was three, my mom realised I had a natural calling for dance," says Geethika, who is the principal dancer and administrator at Sutra Foundation (Sutra).

When the pandemic halted big social gatherings, not being able to teach classes or perform was not a good feeling for Geethika.

A Community Approach to the Plastic Waste Problem

Plastic use is as easy as drug-use. They are light, easily shaped, strong and inexpensive. Their ability to guard against contamination makes them useful in sterile medical environments such as hospitals or even to store away leftovers.

We know they are bad — for the earth, animals and humans. Yet, the world can't live without plastics. But are plastics really all that bad? Or it is our behaviour that gives them a bad reputation?

The Biji-Biji Initiative through its Beyond Bins Project invites you to consider recycling and better plastic waste management.

Tapping into Abilities, and Not Disabilities

Special needs teacher Cikgu Zulkarnain bin Omar will always remember the day one of his students' parents asked him in earnest, "What will my child do after completing school?"

He would later contribute to the development of the Secondary School Alternative Assessment for students with Special Needs (PASM), a project led by Dr. Khodori Ahmad, founder and chairman of KNK Total Assessment, with his highly able team in collaboration with the Malaysian Examinations Syndicate.

PARTNERSHIPS



In response, a collaboration framework known as the Government-Linked Companies (GLC) and Government-Linked Investment Companies (GLIC) Disaster Response Network was developed to streamline and coordinate contributions from GLICs and GLCs, to avoid redundancy of efforts and optimise resources.

2021 saw over RM207.2 million in funding channelled to help communities affected socio-economically by the pandemic and later in the year, the massive and sudden floods in December. GDRN was later reintroduced as "GLC Demi Rakyat & Negara" in March 2022, along with a new strategy to expand its role in social impact coordination among GLCs.

Valued at RM15 billion and comprising a total of 22 initiatives, *Pakej Bantuan Perlindungan Ekonomi & Rakyat Malaysia* (PERMAI) anchors upon three objectives – combating the COVID-19 outbreak, safeguarding the welfare of the people and supporting business continuity.



Under Initiative 6: Strengthening Welfare Programmes, RM 25 million was allocated by the government towards the Government-Linked Companies (GLC) and Government-Linked Investment Companies (GLIC) Disaster Response Network (GDRN) as a matching grant to the donations made by GLCs/GLICs for social initiatives.

Through GLCs and its implementing partners, Yayasan Hasanah has disbursed RM16.5 million of the PERMAI fund, benefiting approximately 200,000 recipients.

When the COVID-19 pandemic caused schools to be suspended, the shift from traditional classroom learning to online lessons had to happen very quickly. For 4.9 million students nationwide, school as they knew it rapidly changed.

To address the digital learning gap for approximately 150,000 students in primary and secondary schools in Malaysia and to pilot digital learning models for future adoption, a corporate responsibility initiative called CERDIK was announced in Budget 2021, driven by Government Linked Companies (GLCs) and Government Linked Investment Companies (GLICs).





Prihatin

Pakej Rangsangan Ekonomi Prihatin Rakyat

Under PRIHATIN, the Ministry of Finance partnered with Hasanah for the Hasanah Special Grant 2021 (HSG 2021), allocating a matching grant of RM25 million to enable expanded reach to more vulnerable communities via grants and social initiatives.

For HSG 2021, 40 projects worth RM22,887,700 were approved for disbursement to benefit 37,600 individuals from target groups spanning across Peninsular Malaysia, Sabah and Sarawak. This included B40 communities, Orang Asal, the elderly, the homeless, refugees, undocumented migrants, at-risk children, women and youth, and persons with special needs.

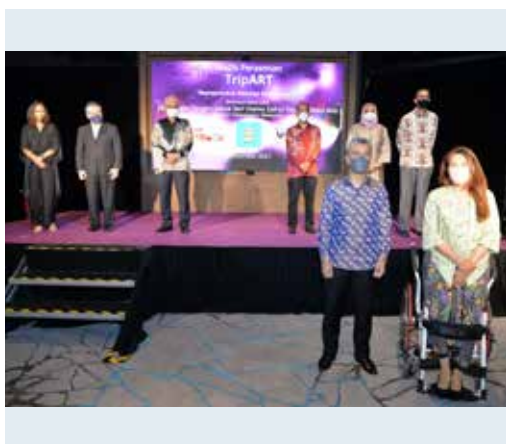
One programme under *Inisiatif 16: Menambahbaik Program Bantuan Rentan Bandar of Program Strategik Memperkasa Rakyat dan Ekonomi (PEMERKASA)* addressed basic food needs with an allocation of RM100 million. The funds were distributed through MyKasih's cashless food aid system utilising the innovative MyKad technology.

For three months, each Prihatin Kasih beneficiary received RM100 monthly, credited in their MyKad to buy rations from appointed partner stores. Being able to choose what they individually needed from a range of approved food categories thus avoided wastage.

Yayasan Hasanah has disbursed RM44 million of the PEMERKASA fund to benefit 137,273 recipients nationwide, to ensure basic food provisions were met for a period of 3 months.

Evidence-based Policymaking and Social Interventions

Through world class research, we strive to formulate more well-informed policies and more effective initiatives.

Perak Sustainable Development Model: A Report by Yayasan Hasanah

Through research and multiple stakeholder engagements, this report aims to develop as a baseline for environmental information in Perak, a state that's home to an abundance of valuable ancient forests and therefore, natural biodiversity.

The proposed framework consists of five thrusts that touch on greening the economy, creating responsible and empowered communities, conserving nature, building resilience against climate change and disasters, and practicing good environmental governance.

Baseline Study: Plastic Value Chain and Plastic Waste Management in Peninsular Malaysia

Responsible plastic management is one of the primary concerns under Hasanah's Environment focus area. This study was carried out to gain insight, gather on-the-ground input and make recommendations in line with the aim to develop a clear and responsible plastics use agenda for Malaysia.

The reality is that plastics are going to stay in our daily lives. So, the real challenge is to figure out how we can live with it in a harmonic and sustainable manner, with necessary legal and economic instruments in place to keep the adverse impacts at a minimum.

Building Resilience: Towards Inclusive Social Protection in Malaysia

The socio-economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic have revealed pre-existing gaps in Malaysia's social protection system.

This report recommends practical, equitable and sustainable policy proposals that are built upon existing social services – such as public healthcare, social housing and the education system – based on a life-cycle approach.

Advocating an inclusive and forward-looking approach to prevent poverty and address vulnerability, the report's recommendations emphasise a universal provision of social protections against major risks at each stage of everyone's life.



Deconstructing Cash and Voucher Assistance (CVA) in the Malaysian Humanitarian Landscape

9 February 2021

The overarching message of the session was that dignity is crucial in all aspects of giving. Offering choice not only gives the people we assist more power and control over their lives, but also has a direct impact on reducing wastage – all of which can be accomplished by implementing CVA.

Moonlighting for Conservation

8 June 2021

This panel discussion sought to recognise, uncover, and learn about a few unconventional individuals who do not hail from the world of environmental conservation, and yet have a strong sense of obligation to support and champion the protection of Malaysia's biodiversity.

The Future of the Platform Economy

29 July 2021

The webinar aimed to provide attendees with a broader perspective of how digital work shapes the national labour policy, as well as the measures taken by the government and non-government bodies to ensure equitable opportunities and protections for all workers in this economy.

Essential Role of the Arts in Society's New Normal

20 April 2021

This webinar conducted by Pam Guneratnam, a psychologist, and Ajim Juxta, an artist, aimed to enlighten attendees about how the arts can be a tool to calm the mind and combat depression or loneliness. 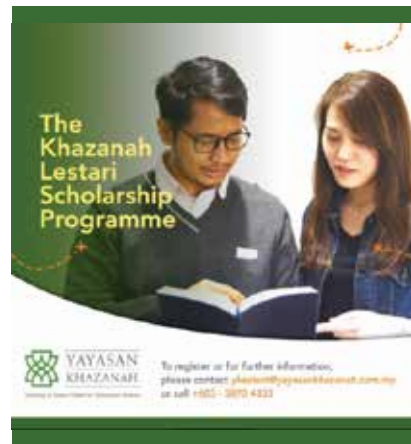

Looking Ahead

In 2022, Hasanah is committed to continuously serve those in need of assistance through solutions and approaches that empower communities, encourage social inclusivity, and improve the environment, all while contributing to 15 of the United Nations' 17 Sustainable Development Goals (UNSDGs).

Humanitarian Disaster Relief (HDR)

HDR provides funding for communities devastated by natural and man-made disasters.

Due to the nature of the fund, it is available all year round. Eligible applicant organisations must be fully registered with the Registrar of Societies (ROS), the Registrar of Companies (ROC) or the Trustees (Incorporation) Act 1952. This fund is open to all projects nationwide.

Hasanah Special Grant (HSG) 2022

Applications are now open for HSG 2022, where a maximum of RM2,500,000 is allocated for selected projects over a period of three years, depending on the duration and nature of each project.

Arts for All Seasons (ArtsFAS) 2022

Launched in 2020 in response to the pandemic that adversely impacted the lives and livelihoods of arts practitioners, ArtsFAS is now a yearly event that takes place in the third quarter of the year.

Applications for ArtsFAS 2022 open in June 2022.



GLC Demi Rakyat & Negara (GDRN)

Moving forward, the newly revamped GDRN's expanded scope will see a larger number of government-linked companies (GLCs) and government-linked investment companies (GLICs) collaborating to spearhead social impact efforts in times of dire need. It is defined by three core initiatives which are Jalanan Ilmu (Education), Jalanan Sejahtera (Community Livelihood Programmes) and Jalanan Kemanusiaan (Humanitarian Response).

Social Enterprise Seed & Growth Funding Grant

The scope of the grant includes innovative solutions in impact areas of education, community livelihood, food security, health and social wellbeing, environmental protection and cultural preservation. Proposals can be implemented over a duration of 12 to 24 months, beginning in August 2022 until July 2024.

Applications are expected to open from June 2022 till July 2022.



Khazanah Scholarship Programme

Yayasan Khazanah's mission is to support Yayasan Hasanah's and Khazanah Nasional's commitment to actively develop human capital and ensure that Malaysia continues to improve its competitive edge in the global arena.

Besides funding, the wealth of opportunities available to Khazanah scholars include leadership and character development programmes, personal development under the guidance of a learning coach, and mentoring by esteemed corporate decision makers.

Khazanah Global Scholarship Programme (A-Level Studies)

Offers opportunities for high-achievers to pursue A-Level studies at Kolej Yayasan UEM (in preparation to further their undergraduate studies at our approved universities abroad).

Applications are expected to open in June 2022.

Khazanah Watan Scholarship Programme (Foundation and Undergraduate Studies)

Offers opportunities for high-achieving Malaysians to pursue Undergraduate studies at selected leading local universities.

Applications are expected to open in June 2022.

Chevening-Khazanah Scholarship Programme (August – Nov 2022)

This global scholarship programme – by the UK government and funded by the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO) and Yayasan Khazanah – awards funding to outstanding Malaysian scholars who possess leadership potential, which enables them to pursue their Master's degree studies for a one-year period in any field at top ranking British universities (as indicated by the Times Higher Education World Reputation Rankings).

Applications are expected to open from August till November 2022.

Rhodes Scholarship for Malaysia, in Partnership with Yayasan Khazanah (June – August 2022)

A Postgraduate scholarship that support exceptional students from around the world to study at the University of Oxford.

Applications are expected to open from 1st June till 31st August 2022.

ACE2 Executive Short Courses (all year round)

Funding for those who would like to up-skill themselves with full-time Executive Short Courses that range between two weeks to three months, covering the course fee and a round-trip economy class ticket (if the course is conducted abroad).

Hasanah Grant Programme

As a grant-giving foundation, we support catalytic, scalable, replicable and sustainable programmes that demonstrate long-term thinking towards delivering positive social impact.

Beyond funding, organisations that partner with us also receive support through strategic and business advice, trainings and workshops, best practice sharing, networking opportunities and knowledge sharing across our network. Hasanah grants are awarded to eligible Civil Society Organisations (CSOs) whose projects are aligned to Hasanah's focus areas strategy.

Banyak kriteria yang menjadikan kita warga yang hebat. Kecekalan setiap individu merupakan salah satu kriteria penting. Kerana itu, kami percaya setiap individu berperanan dalam menjadikan Malaysia sebuah negara yang hebat.

Laporan kali ini membawa tema Cekal Mengharungi Cabaran, tema yang menggambarkan 2021 secara keseluruhan buat Yayasan Hasanah, rakan-rakan kerjasama serta pihak-pihak yang memerlukan.

Ditubuhkan pada 1 Julai 2015 sebagai yayasan penganugerahan geran bebas di bawah Khazanah Nasional Berhad (Khazanah), Yayasan Hasanah (Hasanah) mendukung usaha-usaha tanggungjawab sosial korporat yang dahulunya diterajui oleh Khazanah selama 9 tahun sebelum diambil alih oleh Hasanah.

Hasanah bermaksud “melakukan kebaikan” dalam Bahasa Arab. Walaupun peranan utama Hasanah adalah sebagai yayasan, kami percaya peranan kami lebih daripada itu; semuanya demi kemantapan ekosistem transformasi.

Seiring dengan aspirasi Khazanah dalam pelaburan demi nilai mampan negara, Hasanah meletakkan harapan dan kepercayaan pada setiap individu yang membentuk sebuah negara.

Tugas kami memberi fokus kepada lima aspek utama – Pendidikan, Pembangunan Komuniti, Alam Sekitar, Kesenian & Ruang Awam dan Pengetahuan – dengan matlamat untuk menjadi perintis, usahasama dan pemangkin kepada perubahan.

Setiap bidang impak mempunyai visi tersendiri. Walau bagaimanapun, visi utama Hasanah adalah untuk membina negara Malaysia yang kohesif dengan pemeraksanaan individu serta pemuliharaan alam sekitar dan seni.

Jumlah individu yang mendapat manfaat Yayasan Hasanah sepanjang tahun 2021 adalah sebanyak 66% daripada jumlah keseluruhan sejak tahun 2015. Sementara itu, jumlah dana yang diurus, rakan-rakan kolaborasi dan projek-projek yang diselia mewakili hampir separuh daripada jumlah keseluruhan sejak penubuhan Yayasan.

Namun begitu, rekod baharu untuk keperluan bantuan yang mendadak ini menjadi peringatan yang mendedahkan jurang dalam sistem perlindungan sosial negara. Pandemik ini menyaksikan realiti pahit di mana ramai individu yang terkesan hebat dalam mengharungi cabaran getir ini.

Dalam merenung kembali perjuangan kita sepanjang pandemik ini, amat penting untuk kita menilai semula sistem perlindungan sosial negara dengan pandangan yang lebih holistik. ”

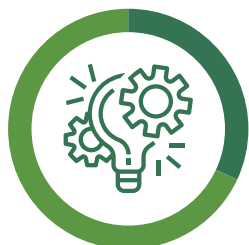

Pendidikan untuk Semua Kanak-kanak

"Saya ingin mendidik komuniti saya dan adik-adik saya," ujar Bilkuin Jimmysali, sambil duduk di belakang Sekolah Bajau Laut Omadal (Iskul Sama Dilaut Omadal dalam bahasa Bajau). Beliau merupakan alumni Iskul yang kini memegang jawatan *Mastal Arikik* atau pembantu guru di sekolah tersebut.

Sekolah alternatif ini dijalankan di sebuah rumah berwarna kuning terang, di tengah-tengah 'sempadan' antara rumah kediaman orang tempatan dan komuniti Bajau Laut tanpa dokumentasi di Pulau Omadal, Sabah.

Lima hari seminggu, sekolah ini meriah dengan riang tawa 33 orang kanak-kanak yang amat dialu-alukan di situ walaupun mereka tiada dokumentasi yang sah.

Tuntung Sungai, Mesin Jahit dan Batik

Apakah persamaan di antarauntung sungai, mesin jahit dan batik?

Pada kebanyakan orang, tiada bezanya.

Namun, bagi Azlina binti Zakaria, 49 tahun (atau lebih mesra dengan panggilan Kak Na), ia menyimpan pelbagai kisah.

Projek pemerksaan komuniti yang dimulakan oleh pengasas bersama Persatuan Konservasi Penyu Malaysia (TCS), Dr. Chen Pelf Nyok yang ditubuhkan pada tahun 2019 membolehkan Kak Na meraih pendapatan sebanyak RM1,000 ke RM1,500 dengan menjahit kraf untuk TCS.

Tetaplah Menari: Masa untuk Refleksi Diri

Sebagaimana penggiat-penggiat seni yang lain, kehidupan penari Odissi Geethika Sree berubah sekelip mata apabila dunia dilanda pandemik COVID19.

“Menari adalah sebahagian daripada hidup saya. Sejak umur saya tiga tahun, ibu sudah nampak bakat semulajadi saya dalam bidang tarian,” ujarnya yang merupakan penari utama dan pentadbir Yayasan Sutra (Sutra).

Pandemik telah menyebabkan aktiviti sosial dihentikan, kerana itu Geethika terpaksa berhenti mengajar atau menari dan ia amat mengganggu emosinya.

Inisiatif Biji-Biji melalui Projek Beyond Bins mengajak anda mengitar semula sisa plastik dan menguruskannya dengan lebih baik.

Asah Keupayaan, Bukan Kekurangan

Guru pendidikan khas, Cikgu Zulkarnain bin Omar tidak akan lupa pada pertanyaan ibu bapa tentang anak istimewa mereka, “Apa yang boleh anak saya buat selepas tamat persekolahan?”

Beliau kemudiannya terlibat dengan pembangunan Penilaian Alternatif Sekolah Menengah (PASM) untuk pelajar-pelajar pendidikan khas, projek yang diketuai oleh Dr Khodori bin Ahmad, pengasas dan pengerusi KNK Total Assessment Sdn Bhd bersama pakar-pakar di dalam pasukannya dan berkolaborasi dengan Lembaga Peperiksaan Malaysia.



Cikgu, juara demi pendidikan saksama

RAKAN KERJASAMA



Apabila negara dikejutkan dengan pandemik COVID-19, Malaysia berhadapan dengan bencana yang tidak pernah dihadapi sebelum ini. Rangka kerja kolaborasi yang dikenali sebagai Rangkaian Tindak Balas Bencana Syarikat Kerajaan (GLC) dan Syarikat Pelaburan Kerajaan (GLIC) telah diwujudkan untuk menguruskan sumbangan daripada GLIC dan GLC bagi mengelakkan usaha yang bertindan di samping memastikan pengurusan sumber yang lebih optimum.

Pada tahun 2021, lebih daripada RM207.2 juta dana disalurkan kepada bantuan berkaitan pandemik serta banjir besar yang menimpa komuniti pada hujung tahun yang sama.

GDRN telah diperkenalkan semula sebagai "GLC Demi Rakyat & Negara" pada bulan Mac 2022 dengan strategi baharu yang berperanan lebih besar dalam koordinasi impak sosial di kalangan GLC.



Dengan nilai RM15 bilion, berbekalkan 22 inisiatif, PERMAI memberi tumpuan terhadap tiga objektif – membanteras wabak COVID-19, melindungi kebajikan rakyat dan menyokong kelangsungan perniagaan.

Di bawah *Inisiatif 6: Mengukuhkan Program Kebajikan*, peruntukan sebanyak RM25 juta telah disediakan oleh kerajaan untuk tujuan GDRN, sama dengan jumlah yang disumbangkan oleh GLC/GLIC untuk tujuan sosial.

Melalui GLC dan rakan kerjasama lapangan, Yayasan Hasanah telah menyalurkan dana PERMAI sebanyak RM16.5 juta, yang memanfaatkan lebih kurang 200,000 penerima sumbangan.

Apabila pandemik COVID-19 menyebabkan sekolah-sekolah ditutup, peralihan pembelajaran daripada bilik darjah ke alam maya harus dilakukan dengan segera. Ini merupakan perubahan drastik oleh sistem persekolahan buat 4.9 juta pelajar di seluruh negara.

Syarikat Kerajaan (GLC)/Syarikat Pelaburan Kerajaan (GLIC) telah bersama-sama menggerakkan inisiatif tanggungjawab korporat iaitu CERDIK yang diumumkan di dalam Bajet 2021. Ianya diwujudkan bagi mengatasi jurang pembelajaran digital untuk lebih kurang 150,000 pelajar di sekolah-sekolah rendah dan menengah di Malaysia dan mengendali model pembelajaran atas talian bagi penerapan untuk masa hadapan.





Prihatin

Pakej Rangsangan Ekonomi Prihatin Rakyat

Di bawah PRIHATIN, Kementerian Kewangan bergabung dengan Hasanah untuk Geran Khas Hasanah 2021 (HSG 2021), dengan memperuntukkan dana sebanyak RM25 juta agar lebih ramai penerima mendapat manfaat daripada geran ini dan juga inisiatif sosial.

HSG 2021 melaksanakan 40 projek dengan dana berjumlah RM22,887,700 yang telah diluluskan untuk tujuan agihan kepada 37,600 penerima di seluruh Malaysia, terutamanya di Sabah, Perak dan Kuala Lumpur. Penerima sumbangan termasuk golongan B40, Orang Asal, warga emas, gelandangan, pelarian, warga asing dokumentasi, kanak-kanak berisiko, wanita dan belia serta individu-individu dengan keperluan tertentu.

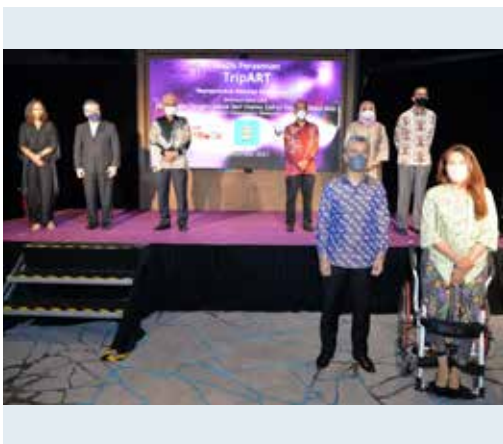
Program di bawah Inisiatif 16: Menambahbaik Program Bantuan Rentan Bandar menyelesaikan isu keperluan asas makanan dengan peruntukan sebanyak RM100 juta. Agihan dilakukan melalui sistem bantuan makanan tanpa tunai MyKasih yang menggunakan teknologi inovatif MyKad.

Setiap individu di bawah Program Prihatin Kasih menerima RM100 sebulan selama tiga bulan yang dikreditkan di dalam MyKad untuk membeli barangan di pasar-pasar raya yang mengambil bahagian. Ini termasuk barangan kering. Ia bertujuan untuk mengelakkan sebarang pembaziran.

Yayasan Hasanah telah menyalurkan RM44 juta dana PEMERKASA kepada 137,273 penerima di seluruh negara, bagi memastikan keperluan makanan asas dapat dipenuhi dalam tempoh tiga bulan.

Intervensi Sosial dan Penyediaan Polisi Berdasarkan Bukti

Melalui kaji selidik bertaraf dunia, kami cuba untuk menyediakan polisi-polisi yang jelas serta inisiatif-inisiatif yang lebih efektif.

Model Pembangunan Lestari Negeri Perak: Laporan Yayasan Hasanah

Melalui kaji selidik dan sesi dialog dengan pelbagai pihak berkepentingan, laporan ini menjadi asas kepada maklumat alam sekitar di Perak, negeri yang kaya dengan hutan simpan yang menyumbang kepada biodiversiti semula jadi.

Cadangan rangka kerja mengandungi lima teras utama yang menyentuh tentang ekonomi hijau, membina komuniti yang bertanggungjawab serta diperkasa, membina daya tahan terhadap perubahan iklim dan bencana, dan mengamalkan sikap prihatin terhadap alam sekitar.

Kajian Dasar: Rantaian Nilai dan Pengurusan Sisa-Sisa Plastik di Semenanjung Malaysia

Pengurusan plastik yang bertanggungjawab merupakan salah satu isu utama di bawah fokus alam sekitar Hasanah. Kajian ini dijalankan untuk mendapatkan pandangan, maklum balas pihak berkepentingan dan memberi saranan bagi membangunkan agenda penggunaan plastik yang bertanggungjawab untuk Malaysia dengan lebih jelas.

Plastik masih kekal relevan dalam kehidupan kita. Maka, cabaran sebenar adalah bagaimana kita menyesuaikan kehidupan dengan lebih harmoni dan lestari, dengan instrumen ekonomi dan peraturan tertentu bagi mengurangkan impak yang buruk.

Membina Daya Tahan: Ke Arah Perlindungan Sosial Menyeluruh di Malaysia

Impak pandemik COVID-19 terhadap sosioekonomi telah menampakkan jurang dalam sistem perlindungan sosial Malaysia.

Laporan ini menyarankan polisi yang praktikal, saksama dan mampan, dibangunkan daripada khidmat sosial sedia ada - penjagaan kesihatan awam, rumah-rumah sosial dan sistem pendidikan - berdasarkan pendekatan kitaran hidup.

Menyokong pendekatan yang menyeluruh dan memandang ke hadapan bagi mengekang kemiskinan dan menangani ketidakstabilan, laporan ini mencadangkan penekanan terhadap perlindungan sosial sejagat terhadap risiko-risiko yang besar pada setiap peringkat kehidupan seseorang.

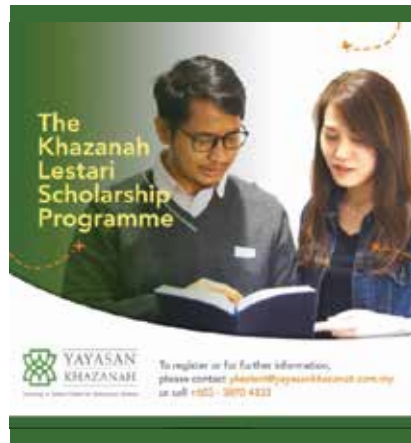

Arts for All Seasons (ArtsFAS) 2022

Program Biasiswa Khazanah

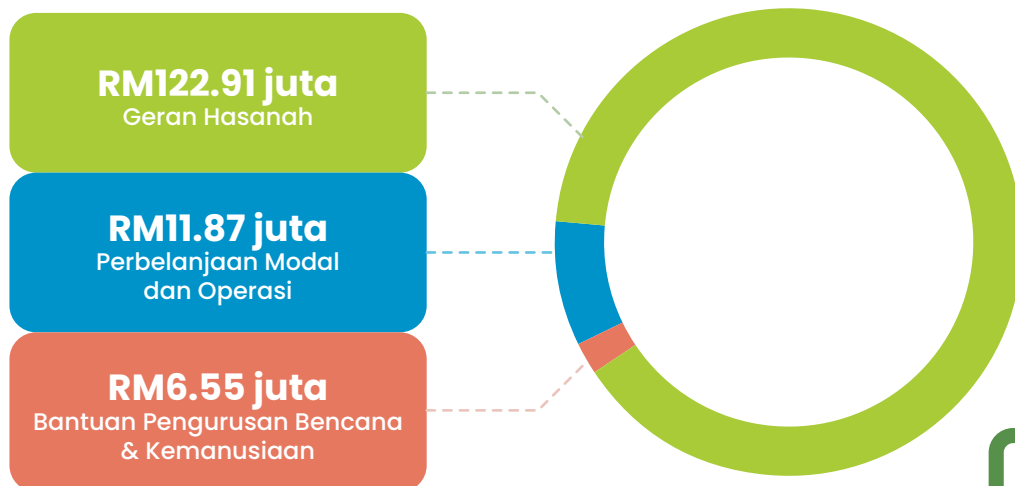

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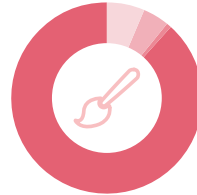

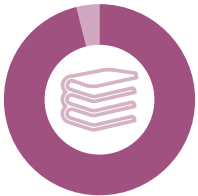
